

Application form – Approval of labelling with SMAK quality label



The approval is subject to renewal 12 months after initial approval. In order to achieve permanent approval the applicant must submit supplementary analyses of glycoalkaloids/TGA. The supplementary analysis must be based on product samples grown in Sweden.

Procedure:

1. Fill in the form
2. Email a copy of:
 - Variety description in Swedish or English
 - Picture of the potato tuber
 - Picture of the sprout
 - Picture of the flower
 - Lab analysis on glycoalkaloids, a new analysis is sent to Svensk Potatis 12 months after approval, then on Swedish-grown potatoes to see if our climate has an impact on the glycoalkaloids and their development.
 - A completed form to: nysort@svenskpotatis.se
3. Send 15 kg of unwashed potatoes for analysis and eyepiece inspection to the lab in Skänninge.

After the analysis, a decision is announced via e-mail. After approving a variety, the variety is posted on Svensk Potatis website: <https://svenskpotatis.se/smak-markning/sorter-for-smak-markning>
4. 12 months after approval, a supplementary analysis of current levels of glycoalkaloids (TGA analysis) must be submitted. The analysis is sent to nysort@svenskpotatis.se
5. After obtaining a renewed approved analysis, a decision is announced whether the variety retains the approval. In the absence of a supplementary analysis, the approval expires, and the variety is removed from the list of approved varieties.
6. A fee of SEK 1,450 is invoiced to applicants upon application. No other fees will be added. The application fee will be used for further work to follow up and research on glycoalkaloids.
